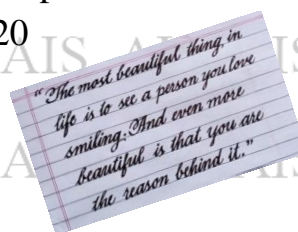
❖ Do all the given holiday homework in a single scrapbook.
