Dear Parents,

Different types of languages are spoken by people from different regions but the most important thing is that, any language, when spoken should be spoken correctly. The two common languages that our children should be able to speak fluently are Hindi and English. Since English is a universal language spoken and understood by people all over the world, we want our children also to be proficient in speaking it and for this we need your full support and cooperation. We would appreciate if you adhere to the following points.

Speak with your child in English

Read out story-books with big illustrations and after finishing the story discuss it with your child. Emphasize more on phonic sounds and encourage Word Building and Picture Talk.

The teachers are trying to encourage the children to use simple words. Phrases and sentences like-

- May I come in ma'am?
- May I drink water?
- May I go to the toilet?
- I am feeling hungry.
- I am feeling thirsty.
- Please sharpen my pencil.
- Please give me a pencil.
- Please give me an eraser, etc.

Use of magic words like excuse me, sorry, thanks, please.

Children can be encouraged to use simple words and sentences at home also

For example:-

- Mom, please give me-something to eat.
- Please give me a glass of water.
- Please trim my nails.
- Please tell me a story.
- Can I watch T.V.?
- Can I go to the park?
- I am feeling sleepy.
- Please buy me a toy.
- Please give me bath.
- Please comb my hair.

Use of magic words like excuse me, sorry, thanks, please.

Wishing people properly-Hello Uncle/Aunty, how are you?

Wishing parents and elders Good morning, Good afternoon, Good evening and Good night.

You can also train them to follow simple instructions like-

Open the door, shut the door, Take your food, finish your breakfast, drink your milk, go to sleep, don't watch too much T.V. brush your teeth, do your work, etc.

If we, as teachers and parents make a sincere effort and pay attention to the above mentioned points we can help our children to learn to understand and speak English from this early age.



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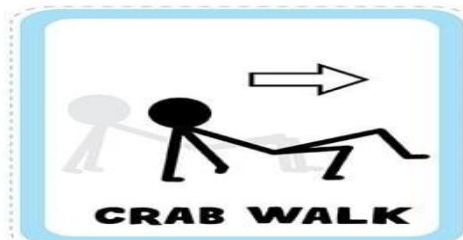
Holiday Home-Work
